



Merino Boucle Hat & Scarf (CTH-120 Free)

SKILL LEVEL:

Beginner

SIZE: Hat, one size fits all.
Scarf, 8" x 41" as shown excluding fringe.

Note: There is ample yarn left to lengthen this scarf if desired.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 1 hank of Merino Boucle

Needles:
US # 9 circular 16"
(you can also use straight needles for the scarf)
Size 9 double-pointed needles
Tapestry needle for sewing and attaching fringe
(crochet hook can also be used for attaching fringe)



GAUGE: 3.25 st per inch in pattern stitch after blocking

INSTRUCTIONS

Hat

1. With circular needles, cast on 80 stitches.
2. Join and mark beginning of row, being careful not to twist.
3. Rib in K1 P1 for 8 rounds.
4. Knit for 2 rounds.
5. Beginning the pattern, in the next round * yarn over, knit 2 together. Repeat from *.
6. Knit next round.
7. Repeat Steps 5 & 6 until work measures 5 1/2 inches from cast on edge, ending with a Step 6.
8. To shape the crown, knit next round.
9. *Knit 2 together, knit 6; repeat from * around.

10. Knit the round.
11. *Knit 2 together, knit 5; repeat from * around.
12. Continue in this manner until round of *knit 2 together, knit 3 has been worked. (Switch to double-pointed needles when necessary.)
13. Knit.
14. Knit 2 together around.
15. Knit 2 together around.
16. To finish, break yarn and using a tapestry needle, thread the tail through the remaining stitches.
17. Block hat lightly.

Scarf

1. If you desire fringe, cut fringe first -- 18 pieces per side (total of 36 pieces) each 14" long.
2. Using #9 circular or straight needles (your choice), loosely cast on 25 stitches.
3. For the Moss Stitch, start with a row of k1, p1 to end.
4. To continue the pattern, repeat Step #3 for all remaining rows. (You will notice that every time you turn your work, you knit the purl stitches and purl the knit stitches.)
5. Knit to desired length.
6. Bind off loosely in pattern stitch.
7. To finish, block lightly and attach 18 pieces of fringe evenly spaced along each end of scarf with crochet hook or tapestry needle.
