



Erdal Lazer Cable V-neck Sweater

Hand knit pattern
Central Maine Knits

Materials Needed:

Erdal Lazer color # 519
Medium 20" W X 22" L
Four 100g balls
4 sts X 5.5 rows per inch



Sweater Back

Cast on 80 sts
Work in 1 X 1 rib for 2" with smaller needles
With larger needles, work in stockinette st for 12" more
Mark sides for sleeves
Work in stockinette for 8.5" more (total 22.5")
Cast off 26 shoulder sts, 28 neck sts, 26 shoulder sts

Front

Cast on 80 sts
Work in 1 X 1 rib for 2" with smaller needle
With larger needle work in stockinette st except for sts before and after cable



(To make cable : knit stockinette 36 sts , purl 1 st, Put next 3 sts on holder and hold to back of work, knit the next three on left needle, put sts from holder on left needle making sure not to twist, knit 3 sts , purl 1 st , finish row in stockinette.)

Continue as above, twisting for cable every 2”.

At 14” mark for sleeves

At 17” split front in half for V-neck.

Working one side, decrease 1 st on neck side 14 times evenly in the last 5.5” (26 sts remain) Cast off

Repeat for other side of front V.

Seam together the shoulder sts

Sleeves

Cast on 36 sts

Work in 1 X 1 rib for 2”

Work in stockinette st for 16” increasing evenly to 62 sts. Cast off

Sew sleeves to sweater.

Sew sleeve and side seams

Weave in and trim all ends.
