SRKW5013 – Crochet Bag

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Small circle diameter 7.5"/19cm, big circle diameter 14"/36cm.

MATERIALS

Super 10 (100% cotton) 200m/100gm
Color #2020- Eden Garden 2 skeins
One size 3.50mm (US E/4) crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

GAUGE

18dc and 9 rows = 4"/10cm in Double crochet using size 3.50mm (US E/4) hook. TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

INSTRUCTIONS

FRONT

Rnd 1: Ch6, join with sl st in the first ch to form ring.

Rnd 2: Ch4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), (dc in ring, ch1) 11 times, join with a sl st in the 3rd ch of first dc.

Rnd 3: Ch5 (counts as 1 dc, ch 2), (dc in the next dc, ch2) 11 times, join with a sl st in the 3rd ch of first dc.

Rnd 4: Ch3 (counts as first dc of 5dc-pc-st), 4dc in the first ch2 sp, drop loop from hook, insert hook from front to back in the top of the beginning ch 3 and through dropped loop and yoh and draw through all loops (popcorn st completed), (ch4, 5dc-pc-st in the next ch2 sp) 11 times, ch2, join with hdc in the top of the beg popcorn st.

Rnd 5: Ch5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), (dc in the next ch 4 sp, ch2, dc in the same ch 4 sp, ch2) 11 times, dc in the last ch 4 sp, ch2, join with a sl st in the 3rd ch of first dc.

Rnd 6: Ch3 (counts as first dc of 5dc-pc-st), 4dc in the first ch2 sp, drop loop from hook, insert hook from front to back in the top of the beginning ch 3 and through dropped loop and complete the first popcorn st, (ch3, 5dc-pc-st in the next ch2 sp) 23 times, ch1, join with hdc in the top of the beg popcorn st.

Rnd 7: Ch4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), (dc in the next ch 3 sp, ch1, dc in the same ch 3 sp, ch1) 23 times, dc in the last ch 3 sp, ch1, join with a sl st in the 3rd ch of first dc.

Rnd 8: Ch4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), (skip next ch1 sp, 3dc-pf-st in following ch1 sp, ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp, ch1, skip next ch1 sp, 3dc in following ch1 sp, ch1) 11times, skip next ch1 sp, 3dc-pf-st in following ch1 sp, ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp, ch1, skip next ch1 sp, 2dc in the last ch1 sp, join with a sl st in the 3rd ch of first dc.

Rnd 9: Ch3 (counts as first dc), (1dc in the next ch1sp, ch1, 3dc-pf-st in ch2 sp (between 2 puff sts of previous row), ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp, ch1, 1dc in the next ch1sp, 3dc in 3dc) 11 times, 1dc in the next ch1sp, ch1, 3dc-pf-st in the next ch2 sp, ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp, ch1, 1dc in the next ch1sp, 2dc in 2dc, join with a sl st in the 3rd ch of first dc. Circle diameter will meas 7.5"/19cm

Starting with next row, work forward and back beg with WS row.

Turn, make 4sl st to start next row from puff st

Rows 1-8: Ch1, pull up a loop 1/2" long or a loop equal to the height of your puff st, 3dc-pf-st in ch2 sp (between 2 puff sts of previous row), ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp, ch1, (1dc in ch1, dc in each dc of previous row, ch1, 3dc-pf-st in the next ch2 sp, ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp) 9 times, turn.

Draw attention that number of dc sts between groups of puff sts will increase on 1 dc in each group every row, in last row you will have 13 dc between each 2 groups of puff sts. DO NOT fasten off.

STRAPS

Cont in puff sts: (ch1, pull up a loop ½" long or a loop equal to the height of your puff st, 3dc-pf-st in ch2 sp (between 2 puff sts of previous row), ch2, 3dc-pf-st in the same sp, turn) 22 times.

Work in this patt for approx 14"/36cm. Fasten off.

With WS facing rejoin yarn to the opposite corner of front and work 2nd strap to match first.

With WS of straps together, connect them by 4 dc in ch2 sp. Fasten off.

BACK

Work same as Front.

SIDE PANEL

Row 1: Ch8 (base),

Row 2: 1sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1sc in each ch to end, ch1, turn. 7 sc.

Row 3 and all foll rows: 1sc in each sc to end of row, ch1, turn.

Work in patt until panel meas approx 28.5"/72cm. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to the first ch1 at the corner of front, work 14sc along side of front, then with WS of front and panel together, sc front and panel together, 14 sc along side of front to the end, fasten off.

With RS facing rejoin yarn to the ch1 of center horizontal part of front (between straps), sc along edge, fasten off.

Rep for back.

General Abbreviations

Beg, beginning; **ch**, chain, chain st; **cont**, continue; **cm**, centimeters; **dc**, double crochet; **dec**, decrease; **foll**, following; **in**, inches; **hdc**, half-double crochet; **inc**, increase; **rem**, remain(ing); **rep**, repeat; **rnd**, round; **RS**, right side; **sc**, single crochet; **sl**, slip; **sl st**, slip stitch; **sp**, space: crochet into a certain space on the previous row instead of crocheting directly into a stitch.; **st(s)**, stitch(es); **WS**, wrong side, **yo**, yarn over.

5dc-pc-st, popcorn stitch: To have the popcorn puff out on the RS, work 5 dc in the same stitch, drop loop from hook, insert from front to back in the top of the first dc of group **and** through dropped loop, yo and draw yarn through stitch and loop on hook.

3dc-pf-st, puff stitch: (Yo, insert hook in stitch or space indicated, yo, pull up a loop ½" long or a loop equal to the height of your last stitch) three times in the same st, yo, pull yarn through all lps on hook.
