



Super 10 Hat

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

SIZES

Toddler (Youth, Adult)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference 17 (18.5, 20)"/43 (47, 51)cm

MATERIALS

Super 10 Multi (100gm)

Balls 1

One size 6.00mm (US 10) circular needle 40cm long OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

One set of 5 double pointed needles size 6.00mm (US 10).

Stitch marker.



GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm in St st using size 6.00mm (US 10) needles and **yarn doubled**. TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

INSTRUCTIONS

With 2 strands of yarn held together and circular needle, cast on 78 (84, 90) sts. Join in round, being careful not to twist sts and placing marker at beg of round.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: Purl.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Continue in St st, knit every rnd, until piece from beg measures 3.5 (4, 4.5)"/9 (10, 11.5)cm.

Top Shaping

Transfer sts to double pointed needles when necessary.

Rnd 1: K1, ssk, k7 (8, 9), k2tog, k1; rep from * to end of rnd. Knit 1 rnd. 66 (72, 78)

Rnd 3: K1, ssk, k5 (6, 7), k2tog, k1; rep from * to end of rnd. Knit 1 rnd. 54 (60, 66)

Rnd 5: K1, ssk, k3 (4, 5), k2tog, k1; rep from * to end of rnd. Knit 1 rnd. 42 (48, 54)

Rnd 7: K1, ssk, k1 (2, 3), k2tog, k1; rep from * to end of rnd. Knit 1 rnd. 30 (36, 42)

Rnd 9: K1, ssk, k0 (0, 1), k2tog, k1; rep from * to end of rnd. Knit 1 rnd. 18 (24, 30)

Adult size only:

Rnd 11: *K2, k2tog, k1; rep from * to end of rnd. 24 sts

All Sizes:

Next rnd: *ssk; rep from * to end of rnd. 9 (12, 12) sts

Break yarn, leaving a long tail for seaming. Thread end through rem sts, draw up and secure.
