



CERAMIC CROCHETED TODDLER CAP

Size:

Fits baby/toddler (12 months to 3 years) with head circumference of 18-20"

Materials:

1 ball (50g) Ceramic (shown in color #7003)
Small piece of clear vinyl or similar material to stabilize visor
Small amount of elastic thread (approx. 12")
Size G (4.5mm) Crochet Hook
Stitch Markers
Optional: Decorative button (as shown) for top of crown

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dec = decrease
sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
sl st = slip stitch

Note:

Use a place marker to mark the last sc of each round.



Directions For Crown:

- Row 1: Ch3, join with sl st to form a ring. Ch1, 6 sc in ring (do not join).
- Row 2: 2 sc in each sc (12 sc).
- Row 3: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc), repeat around.
- Row 4: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc), repeat around.
- Row 5: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc), repeat around.
- Row 6: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 4 sc), repeat around.
- Row 7: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 5 sc), repeat around.
- Row 8: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 6 sc), repeat around.
- Row 9: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 7 sc), repeat around.
- Row 10: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 8 sc), repeat around.
- Row 11: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 9 sc), repeat around.
- Row 12: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 10 sc), repeat around.
- Row 13: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 11 sc), repeat around.
- Row 14: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 12 sc), repeat around.
- Row 15: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 13 sc), repeat around.
- Row 16: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 14 sc), repeat around.
- Row 17: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 15 sc), repeat around.
- Row 18: Sc in each sc to end of round. Place marker in last stitch.

Directions For Visor Flaps:

1. Work in back loop of stitches from this point forward unless instructed otherwise.



- Row 1: (Right side): Work sc in next 19 stitches, ch1, turn.
 - Row 2: Sc in each sc, ch1, turn.
 - Row 3: Skip first sc, sc to last 2 sc, work a dec in these last 2 sc, ch 1, turn.
 - Rows 4-8: Repeat Row 3.
2. Cut yarn and fasten off.
 3. Working in unused front loops of the 19 sc, rejoin yarn and repeat row 1-8 of visor to create second flap.

Finishing:

Note: From this point, you will work through entire sc stitch and not just the back loop.

1. Attach one end of elastic to edge of Row 1 of visor and attach the other end of the elastic to the other edge of the visor, leaving the center portion of the elastic facing towards the back of the crown.
2. Trace a visor flap on paper to make a template then using the template, cut out a crescent shape of it on the vinyl.
3. Join yarn in last sc of row 18 (at marker) and sc in same st as joining. Working through both layers of the visor, sc evenly along the side and over the top (Row 8) of visor. Insert the vinyl between visor flaps and continue to work down remaining side stitches of visor. Do not fasten off.
4. Holding the elastic thread along Row 18 of crown, continue to sc, working over the elastic thread until you approach the last sc. At this point, undo elastic and gently pull to gather back portion of cap crown, then cut off any excess elastic and re-attach it to the last stitch then sl st to first sc of round, ch1, work another round of sc's around entire cap, sl st to beginning ch 1 of round. Cut yarn and fasten off.
