



Ribs on Auto Stripe Hat & Scarf

WR1895



Designed by Darla Sims.

Scarf: 5" wide x 62" long.

Hat measures 16" and will stretch up to 22".

RED HEART® "Stripes™": 2 skeins 942 Sonoma Stripe

Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10].

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 26 sts = 5"; 18 rows = 4" in Pattern stitch.

CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the specified gauge.

SCARF

Cast on 26 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): P2, *k4, p2; repeat from * across.

Row 2: K2, *p4, k2; repeat from * across.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 60" from beginning.

Bind off.

HAT

Cast on 79 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): *P2, k4; repeat from * to last st, p1.

Row 2: K1, *p4, k2; repeat from *.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 7" from beginning, end with a wrong side row.

Shape Crown

Row 1 (Right Side): K1, *k2tog; repeat from * across – 40 sts.

Row 2: *K2tog; repeat from * across – 20 sts.

Row 3: *K2tog; repeat from * across – 10 sts.

Bind off.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close. Knot to secure.

FINISHING

Sew back seam of hat.

Weave in ends.
